GENERAL INFORMATION

Membership Fees

Members are reminded that fees are payable in advance and are therefore due on or before 01 January each year.

Address of Members

Members shall notify the Secretary in writing immediately upon change of address, and telephone numbers. Members are requested to provide the Club with their email address if they have one. Complaints

All complaints on any matter connected with the management or service of the Club or the conduct of any employee of the Club shall be made to the President, who may, if necessary, insist that such complaint be made in writing.

If the President is unable to satisfy the complainant or complainants, then he/she shall submit the matter to the Board for review and decision.

Members and VISITORS

All members and visitors to the playing course, practice area and general area are required upon arrival to lodge your name(s) and sign the PGC entry book located at the Pro Shop, including the reason for your visit ie. Play golf, walking, practice etc.

Dress Standards

The Board expects all members and guests of the Club to be suitably attired in clean apparel and footwear both on the course and in the clubhouse.

The Board reserves the right to refuse entry to anyone not conforming with the requirements as displayed at the entry to the Clubhouse

Course Etiquette

No player shall play until the players in front are out of range. Any group failing to hold its place on the course and loses more than one clear hole on the players in front shall allow the group following to pass.

When the play of a hole is completed, players shall move to the next tee before marking their cards. The player with the honour shall play before marking their card.

Players are responsible for repairing their own divot marks and bunker marks and are encouraged to repair others. No one shall move, talk or stand close to or directly behind the ball or hole when a player is addressing the ball or making a stroke.

The lowest handicapped player in each group is responsible for the observance of the rules of golf and etiquette. This does not however, relieve all players of their responsibilities under the rules of golf.

Slow play is contagious - help to eliminate it. PGC Supports and Encourages "Ready Golf"

LOCAL RULES

- 1. Out of Bounds Rule 18.2
- Beyond any wall, fence, garden edge or white stakes with black tops defining the boundary of the course or where otherwise specified. *Stroke and distance penalty to be applied
- All paved/ concrete areas around the clubhouse, golf pro shop and parallel to the first tee. *Stroke and distance penalty to be applied

Stoke and distance penalty - If a ball enters an out of bounds area from the tee or during general play, the player must return to the original position where the stroke was taken and retake their shot, with an additional one stroke penalty. E.g., a players 2nd shot goes out of bounds, they are hitting their 4th shot from the original position.

2. <u>Abnormal Course Conditions including Immovable Obstructions – Rule 16 Ground Under Repair</u>

- Those areas defined by white stakes, white lines or marked as GUR, except in a penalty area, are to be treated as GUR.
- Bare patches on the greens that have been caused by weed spray or dry areas (lie of ball only), lift and place to nearest point no nearer the hole.
- Bare patches on the fairway of the hole you are playing, the player may take free relief at the nearest point not nearer to the hole.
- If a ball comes to rest in any of the below situations, the player may take free relief at the nearest point not nearer to the hole that avoids such situation:
 - Clearly defined wheel ruts made by mowers, tractors or motor vehicles, all defined garden beds on the course, gravel roads near 3rd/6th/18th tee, gravel roads along 3rd/6th/7th fairway. All other paths/tracks are to be treated as an integral part of the course (no relief available).
 - o Machinery sheds, Cart sheds and Greenkeepers refuge to the east of the 14th green.
 - Bare patches with embedded rocks that may cause damage to club or injure player. <u>Bare patches without embedded rocks are not permitted free relief.</u>
 - Exposed tree roots on fairway being played.
 - Earth cracks due to dry conditions.
 - Any damage caused by an animal (kangaroos, cockatoos, etc.).

3. Compulsory GUR

During play on the 15th hole, if a player's ball comes to rest within one club length of the halfway house, they **must** take GUR relief at the nominated drop zone.

4. Drop Zones

Players required to use the nominated drop zones must drop ball, at knee height, within 2 club lengths of the staked location.

5. <u>Immovable Obstructions</u>

Tree guards, hazard pegs, water taps, fixed irrigation pipes, ball washers, stakes defining protected trees, protective screens, all posts, chains, ropes, drainage grates, fixed seats, fixed signs, mulch around trees, sand bins, sand bucket stands, garbage bins, and fixed sprinkler heads that affect the stance of the player. Only if a swing or stance is impeded by any of the above, a player is able to take free relief to the nearest point, no nearer to the hole. One club length is permitted and must be completely clear of interference from the obstruction. Obstructions in the line of play does not qualify for free relief.

6. Movable Obstructions – Rule 15.2

All white hoops, removable signs, chains, hazard pegs (NB: must be replaced)

7. Halfway House

The halfway house is in play. If a players shot is unable to be made, an unplayable penalty and relief is to be taken.

8. <u>Preferred Lies</u>

Will depend on the course conditions and will be sign posted at pro shop.

RED - Front area of the green - WHITE - middle area of the green - BLUE - Back area of the green

Distance Markers

White posts on sides of fairway indicate 100metrs to centre of green, Blue posts indicate 150 metres to centre of green and Red posts indicate 200 metres to centre of green
